



Shoshazan Engyoji Temple

Shoshazan Engyoji Temple is the 27th temple of the 33 Sacred Sites in Saigoku. opened by Shoku Shonin in 1966. It boasts a vast temple on the mountain with an area the size of 11 Tokyo Domes, and is also known as the "Mt. Hiei of the West.
